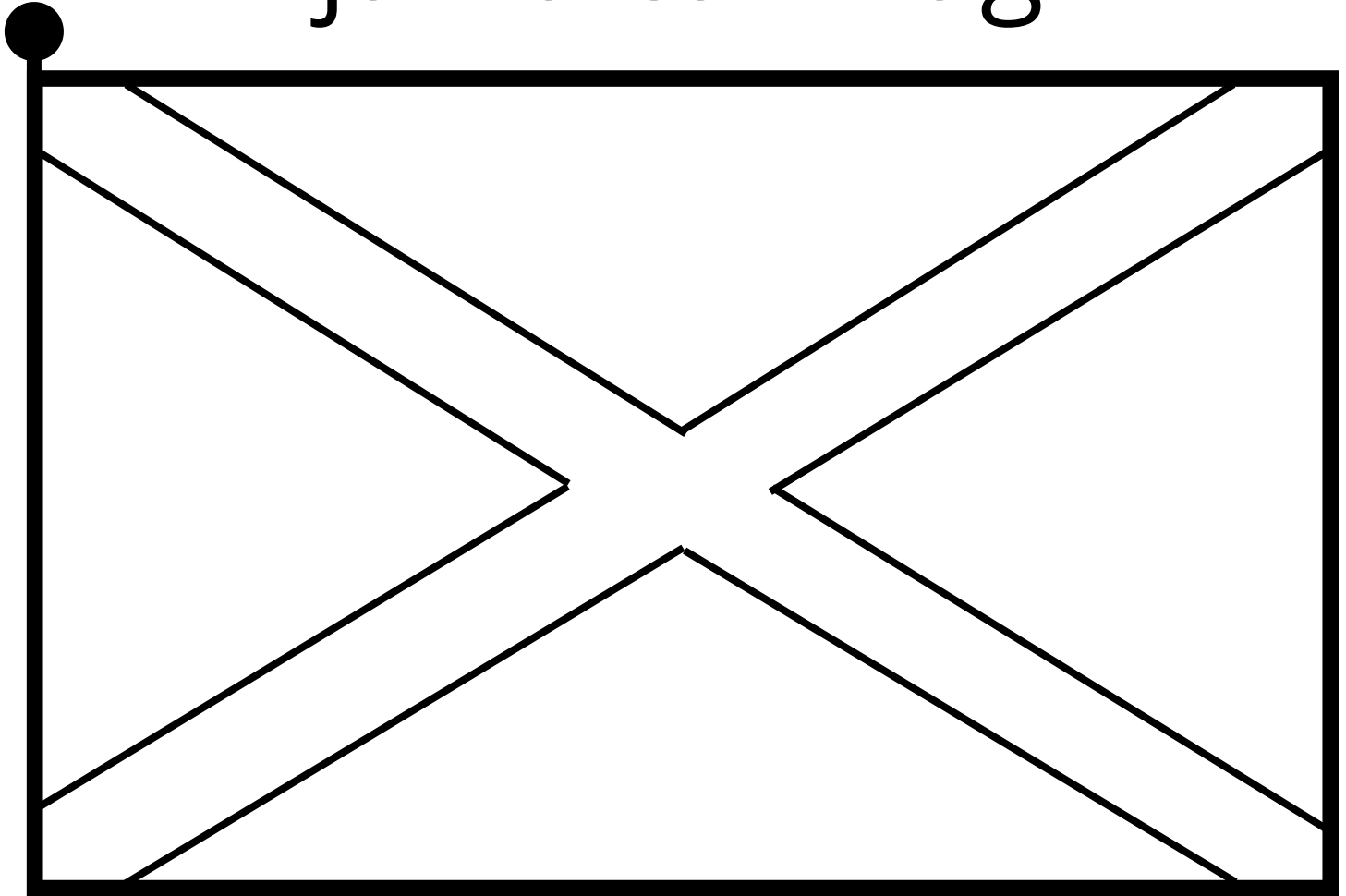


Granny's Kitchen Maze
